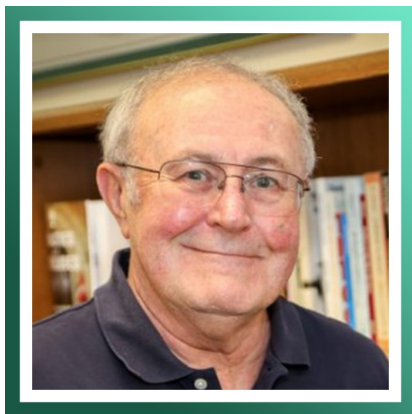

DFW RDC Updates

Kurt Beron, Professor of Economics, was (re)elected to a three-year term as Chair of the DFW Research Data Center Consortium Board at its meeting in December. The DFW RDC provides access to a library of restricted-use data to qualified researchers for projects that often appear in the top economic, sociology, demography, health, and management journals.

A number of researchers at UTD currently have projects at the RDC or are developing submissions for using the RDC. Beron has worked with UTD's Office of Research to provide seed grant funding to encourage UTD researchers to submit proposals to the RDC that may eventually be eligible for external funding.
